CATCH My Breath is a youth e-cigarette prevention program that targets 5th-12th graders to prevent them from starting to vape.



Randolph County Public Health implemented the program at Uwharrie Ridge 6-12 during the month of October 2023.

There were **90** 7th graders that went through the program at Uwharrie Ridge 6-12.





This program will help to prevent youth from starting to vape. Harmful chemicals such as propylene glycol and vegetable glycerin can be found in vapes. Nicotine is also highly addictive for youth.




"It was a very good program." -Student 3
